

CREATIVE WORKSHOPS AT MOORE MUSEUM

After a long winter at home, perhaps spring makes you want to get out of the house and try something new. With that in mind, Moore Museum is offering a series of workshops for you to explore different creative outlets, inspired by heritage handicrafts of the past.

Workshop outline:

Sunday, April 10 – 2 to 4:30 p.m. – Learn to Crochet – In this workshop you will learn basic crochet stitches and make a small project to take home. Cost \$30 per person, including all materials and HST.

Sunday, April 24 – 2 to 4:30 p.m. – Needle Felting – Try your hand at this intriguing craft to fashion decorations from wool roving. Cost \$35 per person, including all materials and HST.

Sunday, May 1 – 2 to 4 p.m. – Watercolour Painting – Artist Amanda Moorehouse will introduce you to watercolour techniques and then provide guidance while you create a painting inspired by Moore Museum's collection. Cost \$35 per person, including all materials and HST.
