TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

BY-LAW NUMBER 49 of 2011

Being a By-law to appoint a Chief Building Official and Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Township of St. Clair

WHEREAS Section 15 of the Police Services Act R. S. O. 1900, c.P.15 authorizes the Council of any municipality to appoint one or more Municipal Law Enforcement Officers, who shall be peace officers for the purposes of enforcing the by-laws of the municipality.

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act 2011 S.O. 2001, c.25 Section 5(3) authorizes the Council of any municipality to appoint certain officers and employees as may be necessary for the purposes of the corporation, or for carrying into effect or enforcing any Act or By-law of the Council.

AND WHEREAS Section 3(2) of the Building Code Act, 1992, S.O. Chapter 23 requires the Council of a municipality to appoint a Chief Building Official and such inspectors as are necessary for the purposes of the enforcement of the Building Act in the areas in which the municipality has jurisdiction;

NOW THEREFORE the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair enacts as follows:

l. That the Chief Building Official of the County of Lambton or Designate, is hereby appointed as the Chief Building Official for the Township of St. Clair for the purpose of the enforcement of the Building code Act, 1992, by Regulation 350/06 and the Building By-law of the Township or their successors in law.

2. That Kelly Bedard and Corrine Nauta be appointed Municipal Law Enforcement Officers for the Township of St. Clair

3. That the said Kelly Bedard and Corrine Nauta shall hold office at the pleasure of Council and subject to the provisions of the above noted applicable law, as amended and shall exercise all authority, powers and right thereof and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statue or by-law are or may be conferred or imposed on the Municipal Enforcement Officers;

4. The said Kelly Bedard and Corrine Nauta shall be paid remuneration in the amount equivalent to a Property Standards/Building Inspector as approved by

County Council.

5. That By-law 27 of 1998 is hereby repealed.
