



**TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

NOTICE OF COMPLETION

THE PROJECT:

St. Clair Township is planning to construct a watermain extension on LaSalle Line from the existing Lambton Area Water Supply System (LAWSS) supply line to an existing watermain near Vidal Street South. The primary purpose of this project is to increase the security of water supply to the Township. A key map, identifying the location of the proposed watermain is shown below.

THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCREENING PROCESS:

The project, is following the planning process established for Schedule B activities under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) document. The Class EA process involves consultation with the public and review agencies to ensure that the project can be carried out in an environmentally-sound manner. The environmental assessment process has now been completed.

If environmental concerns arise regarding this project, which cannot be resolved in discussion with the Township of St. Clair, a person or party may request that the Ministry of Environment and Climate Change make an order that the project comply with Part II of the Environmental Assessment Act, which addresses individual environmental assessments. Requests must be received by the Minister, at the address below, within 30 calendar days of the above-noted meeting. A copy of the request must also be sent to the Township and consulting engineers at the address noted. If no such request is received by April 1, 2015, the project will proceed to implementation as planned.
