TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

BY-LAW NUMBER 19 of 2007

Being a by-law to regulate traffic speed on the St. Clair Parkway

WHEREAS the St. Clair Parkway is a highway owned by and under the jurisdiction of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001 as amended by Bill 130 gives a municipality the authority to impose traffic speed limits on roads and highways under its jurisdiction;

AND WHEREAS the Township, in an effort to improve public safety and in the exercise of its natural person powers hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That the vehicular speed limit on the St. Clair Parkway south of Corunna of 50 KPM be extended approximately 500 feet to the south to a location shown as "location A" and the attached Schedule "I" to this by-law.
- 2. That this by-law shall take effect once the appropriate signage, including advance warning signs are in place.
