

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR
BY-LAW NUMBER 45 of 2007

Being a by-law to authorize execution of a Conservation Agreement with Ducks Unlimited Canada for developments in Branton-Cundick Park St. Clair Township.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair authorizes execution of a Conservation Agreement with Ducks Unlimited Canada with respect to lands described in the agreement attached as Schedule 1 to this by-law.

NOW THEREFORE, in pursuance of the Municipal Act and all other powers thereunto enabling, the Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair enacts as a By-law as follows:

1. That the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair authorizes execution of a Conservation Agreement with Ducks Unlimited Canada a copy of which is annexed hereto and identified as Schedule 'I' to this by-law.
2. The Mayor and the Chief Administrative Officer, or their designates are hereby authorized and empowered to enter into and to execute the agreement on behalf of the Corporation and to affix the corporate seal thereto.
3. This By-law shall not come into force or take effect until the agreement has been fully executed by both parties.
