Meeting returned to order

At the appointed time the Chair on behalf of the Committee welcomed Mr. Dave Moody of Sarnia Lambton Economic Partnership, Mr. Rick Prudom and Mr. Paul Healy representing the Sarnia Industrial Alliance, present to discuss with Council efforts to investigate a route that would accommodate the movement of relatively large modules constructed at various fabrication facilities to the St. Clair river for either shipment West for eventual use in the Alberta Oil Sands project or easterly by water. Mr. Healy pointed out the local economic benefits of such a manufacturing initiative and the four possible routes and St. Clair river destinations being studied. It was hoped that if a decision is made on the preferred route, efforts would be made to improve that route to provide for a minimum of disruption to vehicular traffic on those streets. At the conclusion of the discussion Mr. Healy stated what the group hopes to achieve is Township and County support for the continued investigation of the best route to get oversized modules from the point of manufacturing to a St. Clair River loading facility. It was also pointed out that there is a possibility that depending on a preferred route and location, perhaps the modules could be constructed in a lay down area adjacent to a roll on dock facility. Mr. Healy also stated that his group would probably seek Municipal assistance in possible Federal or Provincial funding opportunities. At the conclusion of the discussion Chair person Carswell-Alexander thanked the three gentlemen for there attendance and the informative presentation.
