Point Edward, ON - Six (6) low-cost rabies vaccination clinics will be held during April and May at Oil Springs and in the townships of Dawn-Euphemia, Brooke-Alvinston and Enniskillen. A seventh clinic will be held in Sarnia; date and location to be announced.
