Deputy Mayor Gilliland:

Deputy Mayor Gilliland advised that the County Creative Committee approved all grants for local projects including: \$3500 to the Moore Museum for their outdoor art project; \$750 for a sign for the proposed Sombra Community Dock and \$1300 to Heritage St. Clair for a community book series. Further, Moore Agricultural Society was awarded \$10,000 for their Celebrating Rural Life Program.

Councillor Agar:

Councillor Agar advised that he attended the Santa Claus Parade which was a wonderful event that grows in quality and popularity each year. He also attended the quarter auction held for the Children's Safety Village which raised \$2400 for the proposed facility.

Councillor Randell:

Councillor Randell congratulated Mayor Arnold for achieving 25 years of service on municipal government. Congratulations Mayor Arnold!

Councillor Kingston:

Councillor Kingston attended the Ontario West Conference in London on December 2, 2016 and provided staff with a copy of the recycling calendar distributed for residents of Wellington County for comparison purposes to our local calendar.

Councillor DeGurse:

Councillor DeGurse advised that Operation Christmas Tree is well underway but, noted that both donations and requests for baskets are down.

Mayor Arnold:

Mayor Arnold represented the Township at a number of events since the last meeting of Council including the Santa Claus Parade and the recent Conservation Ontario meeting in Toronto where they voted on carte blanche significant wetland status for all wetlands within Ontario as well as other woodland issues. Mayor Arnold voted not to consider all wetlands as significant which would render land in these areas as undevelopable.

Mayor Arnold ordered 500 stickers with a specially designed Township logo commemorating Canada's sesquicentennial 150th birthday, along with some hats which should be delivered shortly.

Mayor Arnold will attend the Christmas supper presented by St. Joseph's School and the upcoming Aboriginal Energy Summit in Toronto where presentations are expected from both Aamjiwnaang and Walpole First Nation communities.
