and seeing nobody in attendance with concerns or support, asked Council if they had any questions.

Mayor Arnold asked that staff prepare a report that shows the expected surplus that will make up the water and waste water reserves as a result of the proposed increases. He continued by advising the 12 sewer classes can now be refined into three classes – residential, commercial and industrial – as there are no longer geographic differences in rates.
