### 1. OPENING REMARKS

The budget for 2020 is impacted by many factors not within the control of the municipality. Among those influences are an increase in insurance premiums of \$87,210; an increase on the waste management contract of \$133,000; an increase in the contracts for the SCRCA and the OPP; and an anticipated assessment reduction for the ongoing demolition at OPG expected to be approximately \$120,000. Further, the ongoing need for increased cyber security and the escalating cost of Microsoft licensing also influence the budget for 2020.

The original Operating Budget submitted by staff showed an increase of \$1,037,705 which has since been reduced to \$682,960.
