TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

BY-LAW NUMBER 27 of 2006

Being a by-law to authorize the use of optical scanning vote tabulators at Municipal Elections.

WHEREAS Section 42 of the Municipal Elections Act, 1996 provides that the council of a municipality may, by by-law, authorize the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections;

AND WHEREAS the council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair considers it desirable to pass such a by-law;

BE IT ENACTED AND IT IS HEREBY ENATED as a by-law of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair by the Council thereof as follows:

The council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair hereby authorizes the use of optical scanning vote tabulators for the purpose of counting votes at municipal elections.

This by-law shall come into full force and take effect as of the date of its passing.
