As presented, the Operating Budget would see an increase of \$607,972 from the 2024 budget in net expenditures. The impact would be an increase of 3.5% on the average single detached residential dwelling within the Township which would represent an increase of \$67.15 on the municipal tax portion of resident's bills (using the average assessment of \$224,063).
