

TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

BY-LAW NUMBER 61 of 2005

Being a by-law to regulate vehicular parking and authorize the placement of the appropriate signs.

WHEREAS The Municipal Act, 2001 and The Highway Traffic Act authorizes a municipality to make regulations to regulate vehicular parking on municipal roads and streets;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council of the Township of St. Clair wishes to regulate parking on a portion of the St. Clair Parkway, in Port Lambton to improve public safety.

NOW THEREFORE be it enacted:

1. That vehicle parking be prohibited on the St. Clair Parkway from the north entrance to the on site parking area of Brander Park to the north lot line of property known municipally as 4530 St. Clair Parkway on both the east and west side of the St. Clair Parkway.
2. That this by-law shall come into force on the passing thereof and that the parking regulations shall be enforced when the appropriate signage has been erected.
3. That this by-law shall be considered to be part of the Townships comprehensive parking regulations and enforced accordingly.
4. That any by-law or portion thereof in conflict with the provisions of this by-law shall be hereby repealed.
