ELEMENT 6: DRINKING-WATER SYSTEM

Owner/Operating Authority

The Corporation of the Township of St. Clair is the Owner and Operating Authority for the St. Clair Water Distribution System No. 260006464.

Source Description

Water is supplied to The Municipality by the Lambton Area Water Supply System (LAWSS) which is situated in the City of Sarnia on the southern tip of Lake Huron at the headwaters of the St. Clair River. LAWSS is owned by the Lambton Area Water Supply Joint Management Board whose municipal members include the Corporation of City of Sarnia, the Corporation of Township of St. Clair, Corporation of Town of Plympton/Wyoming, Corporation of Village of Point Edward, Corporation of Township of Warwick and the Corporation of the Municipality of Lambton Shores.

The raw water source is the St. Clair River. The general characteristics for the water from the St. Clair River are typically low in turbidity, slightly basic and low in conductivity. The temperature fluctuates significantly through the seasons ranging from approximately 2°C in the winter to as high as 25°C during the summer. Bacteriological analysis indicates the raw water quality is relatively good quality. Some potential threats would include agricultural runoff, spills from cargo vessels travelling between the upper and lower Great Lakes and international upstream discharges from Municipalities and local industry. Some operational challenges may include ice, algae and storms or hurricane weather. OCWA monitors LAWSS raw water source.

LAWSS is a direct filtration surface water treatment facility with a total design capacity of 181,844 m3 per day. LAWSS supplies sufficient disinfection to meet the regulatory requirements within the distribution systems. Supplemental rechlorination is practiced at the East Lambton Station which supplies water to the Corporation of the Township of Warwick, Corporation of the Town of Plympton-Wyoming, Corporation of the Municipality of Brooke-Alvinston and the Municipality of Lambton Shores. The West Lambton Booster Station rechlorinates as required to supply secondary disinfection for the Corporation of the City of Sarnia and the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair distribution networks.

System Description

Treated Water is supplied by LAWSS 210000906 and distributed to the customers of the St. Clair Water Distribution System 260006464. The system has one rechlorination point at the Brigden Elevated Water Tower and has emergency interconnections with adjoining Municipalities. A SCADA system monitors pressure, flow, and chlorine residual at the Brigden Elevated Water Tower. Distribution system continuous monitoring is located at the Port Lambton Storm Station to monitor for chlorine residual as a daily operational check as per O. Reg. 170/03. An auto flusher at the Port Lambton Storm Station is utilized when necessary to increase chlorine residuals in the south end.

Distribution System sampling and testing requirements as per O. Reg. 170/03 are conducted by OCWA. Customers are metered for water usage. Replacement of aging infrastructure is performed under Capital Projects.

The St. Clair Water Distribution System No. 260006464 is currently supplying drinking water at St Clair Parkway and LaSalle Line as well as Virgil Avenue and LaSalle Line to the City of Sarnia Water Distribution System No. 260003136, owned and operated by the City of Sarnia. The City of Sarnia Water Distribution No. 260003136 is currently supplying St Clair Water Distribution System No. 260006464 at Plank Road North of LaSalle Line.

ELEMENT 15: INFRASTRUCTURE MAINTENANCE, REHABILITATION AND RENEWAL

The Coordinator of Operations Water/Wastewater with the assistance of the Water/Wastewater Specialist plans and authorizes all Infrastructure Maintenance. Inspection and maintenance plans are developed according to a combination of: manufacturer's instructions, regulatory requirements, industry standards, risk based assessments, equipment operating history and/or client requirements.

Infrastructure inspection and maintenance is performed through programs including valve exercising, watermain flushing, hydrant maintenance, chlorine residual sampling, backflow testing and meter calibration. Infrastructure Maintenance is scheduled and managed through a Computerized Maintenance Management System (CMMS) and record sheets. Planned Infrastructure Maintenance is communicated by monthly reports to the Owner.

The ORO or Operator-In-Charge (OIC) authorizes all unplanned infrastructure maintenance in a timely manner. Unplanned Infrastructure Maintenance is scheduled and managed through the CMMS and record sheets. Unplanned Infrastructure Maintenance is communicated by monthly reports to the Owner.

Infrastructure rehabilitation and renewal needs are considered every calendar year in consultation with the Coordinator of Operations Water/Wastewater, the Coordinator of Engineering, the Director of Public Works and the Water/Wastewater Specialist. The 10-year capital plan provides a long-term list of major recommendations and is reviewed at this time. Work order history, record sheets, inspection reports and regulatory standards are reviewed for Infrastructure Renewal and Rehabilitation needs. The Coordinator of Operations Water/Wastewater and the Coordinator of Engineering submit the Capital Budget Reports to the Director of Public Works for inclusion in the Capital Budget Plan to the Owner annually.
