



New Changes to Recycling and Waste Collection

Effective July 1, 2019

Recyclables will continue to be completed by Emterra Environmental. Waste, yard waste, Christmas trees and dumpsters, will be collected by Waste Management of Canada Corporation.

Collection Routes, Waste and Recycling (See Maps)

Corunna: Collection has been split into Thursday (north of Cameron St.) and Friday (south of Cameron St.). The centerline of Cameron St. is the boundary line.

The Northeast section: of the Township (bordered by Lasalle Line, Kimball Road, Courtright Line and Mandaumin Road) will now be collected on Tuesdays, rather than Mondays.

The St. Clair Parkway: will now be collected on either Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, depending on service area.

Single Sided (mail box side) Route Collection

Single sided collection of waste and recycling will be completed on rural roads; except for the following — Bentpath Line, Brigden Road, Courtright Line, Kimball Rd, Lambton Line and Petrolia Line. These will continue to be collected on both sides of the road. For all other rural roads, please place your receptacles on the mailbox side of the road. This change is to allow for efficiencies to routes and affords a lower environmental impact.

Recycling

Recyclable materials must be placed in a blue box container clearly marked 'Recycling' or with a recycling symbol (materials placed in clear plastic bags will not be collected) Please see back page for acceptable receptacles.

Now acceptable — Polycoated hot beverage cups (Tim Hortons, McDonalds, Starbucks) will now be accepted for recycling. Coffee pods made from #5 and #6 plastic (K-cups), will now be accepted for recycling but must be cleaned of coffee grounds. **Plastic Bags of any kind will not be accepted.**

Yard Waste (see maps)

Yard waste will no longer be collected in plastic bags. Plastic bags are not biodegradable and require extensive costly de-bagging services, which are no longer offered at the composting site. All yard waste (lawn clipping, leaves, etc.) must be placed inside large biodegradable **paper** compost bags or open containers with handles clearly marked with an X on both sides. Fall yard waste collection for South township will be Mondays, North township will remain the same.

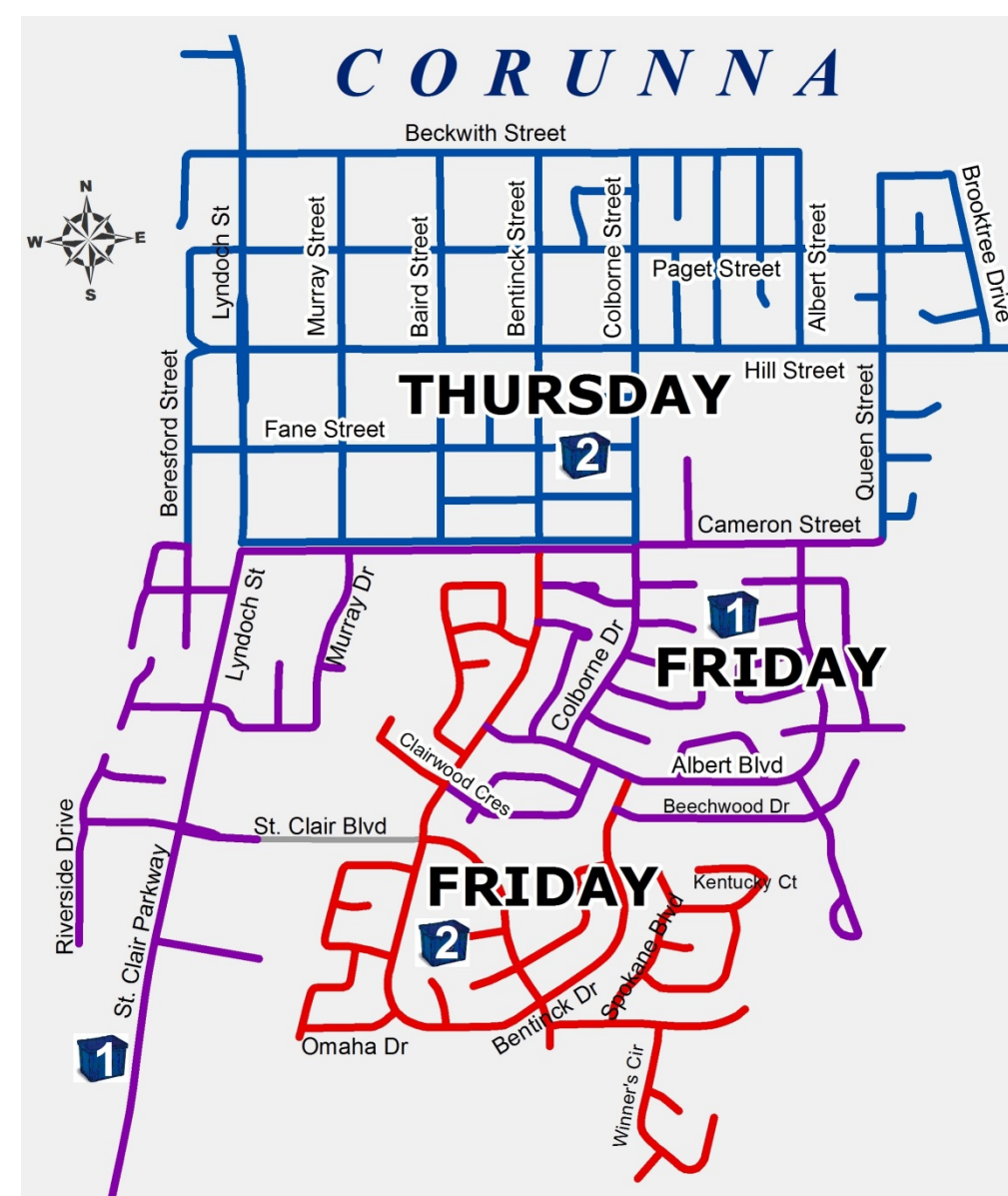
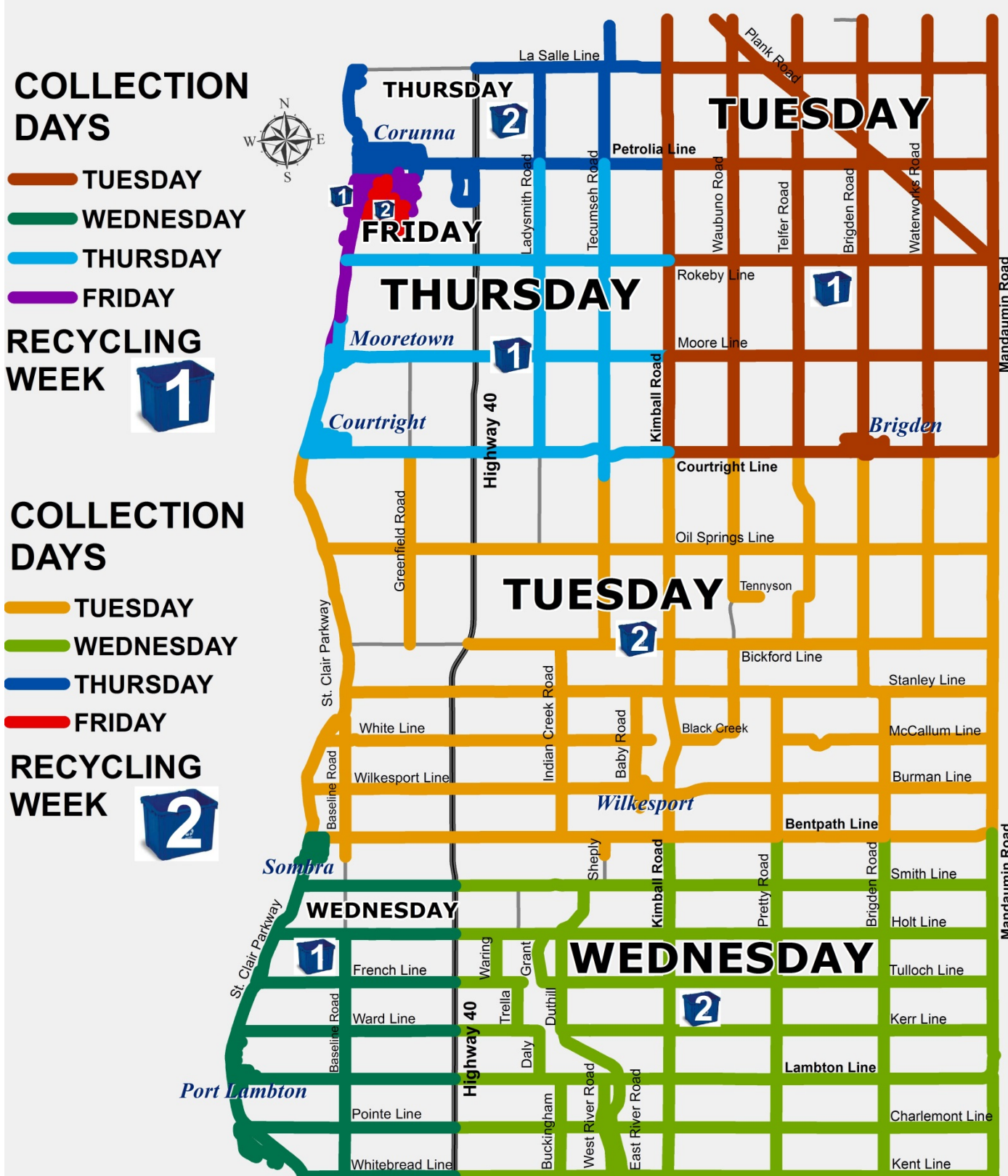

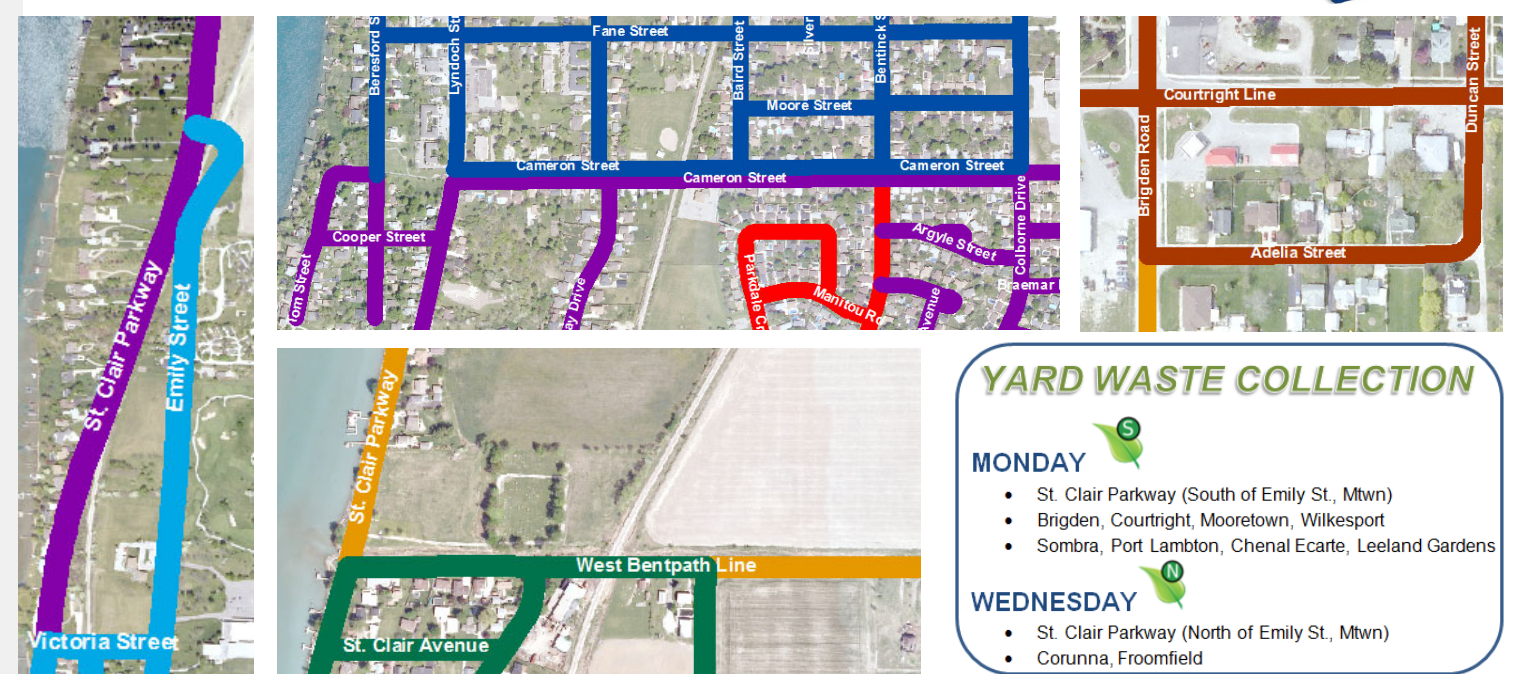
