

**TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 45 OF 2010**

Being a By-law to enter into an Agreement with Majesty the Queen in right of Ontario as represented by the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services – Provision of Police Services

**WHEREAS** Section 4(1) of The Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P>15, as amended, requires that the Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair provide adequate and effective police services in accordance with its needs;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 5 of The Police Services Act permits the Municipality's responsibility for providing police services to be discharged by entering into an Agreement with the Solicitor General under Section 10 of the Act (which have been transferred to the Minister of Community Safety and Correctional Services pursuant to Order-in-Council 1708/2003);

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair has expressed its intent to provide police services, in pursuance of its responsibilities under S.5 of the Police Services Act, by means of the Agreement;

**AND WHEREAS** this Agreement reflects the intent of the parties to provide a level of police services for the Municipality as set out in the Contract Policing Proposal, dated August 19, 2010.


**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair enacts as follows:

1. THAT the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair enter into an agreement with The Ministry of Community Safety and Correctional Services in pursuance of the Corporation's responsibilities under S.5 of the Police Services Act;
2. THAT Schedule "A" attached to this by-law is the Contract Policing Proposal dated August 19, 2010;
3. THAT the Mayor and Clerk are authorized to execute such agreement and any related documents and affix to it the Corporate Seal.

**READ** a first, second and third time and finally passed this 20th day of September, 2010.
