TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

BY-LAW NUMBER 46 OF 2010

A By-law to regulate the erection of signs for the St. Clair Township 2010 Municipal election

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair regulates the erection of signs for the St. Clair Township 2010 municipal election under this bylaw the following regulations are in effect:

- no permit is required for the erection of election signs
- no sign shall exceed 50 square feet
- signs may be erected in any zone
- signs may not be erected on private property without the owner's consent
- signs shall not be placed within 30 meters of a municipal building, facility or designated polling place
- signs will be permitted on local municipal road allowance property but will be restricted to areas and locations that do not obstruct vision for vehicular or pedestrian traffic
- any sign erected, that in the opinion of the Chief Returning Officer, violates any provisions of this by-law will be ordered removed.
- signs must be removed within 48 hours after the day of the election. The municipality will remove the signs at the candidates expense plus administrative costs if the signs are not removed within the prescribed time.
