## TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 58 of 200**

Being a by-law restricting weight on certain municipal streets.

\*\*\*\*\*

WHEREAS section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, as amended provides that:

The Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway or street may by by-law designate a reduced, specific weight limit on the said highways or streets.

AND WHEREAS the reduced weight limits is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways and streets of the Township of St. Clair;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair enacts as follows:

- 1. That the maximum vehicular weight be established at 5 tonnes per axel for Eighth Street and Main Street in the Community of Courtright from Lambton County Road #80 to Main Street and Eighth Street to the St. Clair Parkway, respectively, as shown on Schedule "1" to this by-law.
- 2. That vehicles operated by or on behalf of the municipality shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.
- 3. That vehicles used exclusively for the transport of milk shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.
- 4. That fire apparatus vehicles operated by or on behalf of the municipality, vehicles transporting waste and public utility vehicles shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.

5. That tractors, harvest equipment and towed or mounted implements used exclusively for the agricultural industry shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.

6. That this by-law shall come into effect on the passing thereof once the appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.

7. That the powers of enforcement of this by-law shall be the same as and consistent with the enforcement powers and protocols as prescribed by the Highway Traffic Act.

8. That the penalties for violation of this by-law shall be those as the maximum allowed in the Highway Traffic Act to be collected as a Provincial Offences Act violation.

9. That the weight restriction imposed by this by-law shall be in effect for the entire calendar year.
