

**TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR**

**BY-LAW NUMBER 58 of 200**

Being a by-law restricting weight on certain municipal streets.

\*\*\*\*\*

**WHEREAS** section 122 of the Highway Traffic Act, RSO 1990, as amended provides that:

The Municipal Corporation or other authority having jurisdiction over a highway or street may by by-law designate a reduced, specific weight limit on the said highways or streets.

**AND WHEREAS** the reduced weight limits is deemed necessary for the protection of certain highways and streets of the Township of St. Clair;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair enacts as follows:

1. That the maximum vehicular weight be established at 5 tonnes per axel for Eighth Street and Main Street in the Community of Courtright from Lambton County Road #80 to Main Street and Eighth Street to the St. Clair Parkway, respectively, as shown on Schedule "1" to this by-law.
2. That vehicles operated by or on behalf of the municipality shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.
3. That vehicles used exclusively for the transport of milk shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.
4. That fire apparatus vehicles operated by or on behalf of the municipality, vehicles transporting waste and public utility vehicles shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.

5. That tractors, harvest equipment and towed or mounted implements used exclusively for the agricultural industry shall be exempt from the provisions of this by-law.
6. That this by-law shall come into effect on the passing thereof once the appropriate signs have been erected and are on display.
7. That the powers of enforcement of this by-law shall be the same as and consistent with the enforcement powers and protocols as prescribed by the Highway Traffic Act.
8. That the penalties for violation of this by-law shall be those as the maximum allowed in the Highway Traffic Act to be collected as a Provincial Offences Act violation.
9. That the weight restriction imposed by this by-law shall be in effect for the entire calendar year.
