

## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF ST. CLAIR BY-LAW NUMBER 31 OF 2018

A By-law to regulate the erection of signs for the St. Clair Township 2018 Municipal election

**WHEREAS** the Corporation of the Township of St. Clair wishes to regulate the erection of signs for the St. Clair Township 2018 municipal election;

**NOW THEREFORE** Council for the Township of St. Clair enacts the following restrictions for the erection of campaign signs for the 2018 municipal election being held October 22, 2018:

- no permit is required for the erection of election signs
- no sign shall exceed 20 square feet
- signs may be erected in any zone
- signs may not be erected on private property without the owner's consent
- signs shall not be placed within 30 meters of a municipal building, facility or property
- signs will be permitted on local municipal road allowance property but will be restricted to areas and locations that do not obstruct vision for vehicular or pedestrian traffic and are subject to consent from the adjacent land owner.
- any sign erected, that in the opinion of the Chief Returning Officer, violates any
  provisions of this by-law will be ordered removed or may be removed by the
  Township. Any sign confiscated by the Township under this provision is recoverable
  and day after October 23, 2018.
- signs must be removed within 48 hours after the day of the election. The
  municipality will remove the signs at the candidates expense plus administrative
  costs if the signs are not removed within the prescribed time.
- Absolutely no signs can be posted until September 4, 2018.
